Engagement summary



Summary

Central Coast Council invited the community to provide feedback on the draft Greater Warnervale Structure Plan between 30 January and 31 March 2023.

The draft Greater Warnervale Structure Plan identifies the longterm vision and principles that will guide future land use planning in the area over the next 20 years. It seeks to ensure future development occurs in a manner that is appropriately located and sequenced, supported by the necessary infrastructure and services required to meet the needs of existing and future residents.

We asked the community to provide feedback via an online form, by adding comments to an interactive map or by attending one of the in-person sessions held at Lake Haven Library.

Engagement results

Feedback across the consultation activity revealed the following:

- The community offered constructive feedback about open space and recreation opportunities
- Comments about the need to balance housing and environmental protection
- Comments regarding the need for new infrastructure in the
- Further clarity needed regarding Warnervale Town Centre and new train station
- Concerns regarding over development, loss of lifestyle and local character
- Concerns regarding land use conflicts between residential and employment areas
- The need for more health and medical services to service the current and future population
- Improvements needed to the road, active and public transport network
- The need to manage waterways and natural areas in a sustainable way.
