Engagement Summary

Between 11 May and 21 June 2020 Council sought community feedback on the Draft Central Coast Waste Resource Management Strategy.

This strategy is being developed to address the complex issue of waste on the Central Coast. The draft Strategy assesses current waste initiatives and seeks to encourage change to help minimise the amount of waste sent to landfill and its impact on the environment. This is an important step in finding solutions that close the loop on waste.

Waste is everyone's issue. Waste management is constantly evolving, and we currently have a unique opportunity to reassess how we handle waste. This Strategy is a step in the right direction to inspire change and minimise the amount of waste that is being sent to landfill and the impact this has on our environment.

What's next

We are currently reviewing the submissions we received during community consultation, and the feedback we received will help shape the final Strategy. Once finalised, the Strategy will be presented to Council for adoption. We will inform the community on the outcome in the coming months.
