Summary

Between 3 March and 1 April 2021 Central Coast Council sought community feedback on the draft concept design for a fenced off-leash dog park at Helen Reserve, Gorokan.

To ensure the upgrades for the off-leash dog park reflect what current and future users want to see, an interactive drawing was presented to the community and used to capture feedback.

Engagement Results

Central Coast residents provided feedback on each of the elements (fencing, shade, water, sections etc.) included in the concept design for the off-leash dog park at Helen Reserve, Gorokan.

106 thumbs up and 9 thumbs down reactions were placed on the concept design. 34 comments were placed on the concept design generating 19 reactions.

Comments received throughout the consultation period included:

- concerns about parking availability in the surrounding streets and suggestions to have park entrance at Gascoigne Avenue only
- suggestion to locate the bins closer to the off-leash area and utilise bins with lids that close to reduce odour for surrounding residents
- suggestion for seating to be located under shade structures
- comments supporting the additional reserve land to be used as a recreational area for the broader community.
