Engagement Summary

Summary

Between 15 February and 15 March 2021 Central Coast Council publicly exhibited the Northern Lakes Floodplain Risk Management Study and Plan.

The draft report was prepared following detailed analysis of the feedback we received from our first round of community consultation, and an assessment of potential flood risk management measures.

We invited the community to attend drop-in information sessions (in person and virtual), submit questions via the online tool and submit feedback via the online submission form.

Engagement Results

Feedback received throughout the exhibition period included:

- potential mitigation measures for properties identified as 'high risk'
- comments about the detail around lake levels
- management options for The Entrance Channel
