John Pete Howard Reserve, San Remo – playspace consultation

Engagement Summary

Between 9 November and 7 December 2020 Central Coast Council sought community input on the proposed upgrade to the playspace at John Pete Howard Reserve, San Remo. The current play equipment has reached the end of its functional life and will be upgraded from the current local level playspace to a district level playspace.

The community were provided with information regarding the project and invited to complete an online survey. The questions asked were designed to assist Council plan the redevelopment in a way that reflects the values and preferences of our community.

Engagement Results

Survey results revealed that:

- 66.7% of participants visit in the afternoon (2pm-5pm)
- 50% of participants will visit the playspace 1-3 times per week
- **54.2%** of the potential users of the playspace are between 3 and 5 years of age
- The top two priorities for visiting the playspace is playing with children in your care (66.7%) and meeting with friends (25%)

What next

Further analysis of the feedback received during the playspace consultation is currently being undertaken. These results will then be used to inform the development of concept plans for the new district level playspace located at John Pete Howard Reserve, San Remo. We will present the finalised plans to the community in the coming months.
